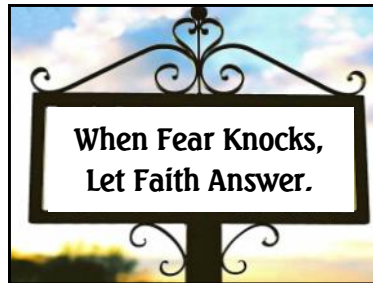
In his book, “Died of Worry”, Dr. John Haggai says, “How to win over worry could be written factually on many tombstones.”

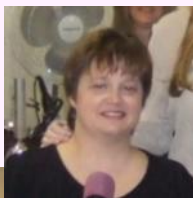

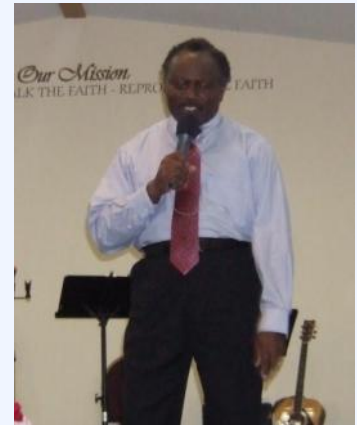

## Youth Rallies Rally Youth!

This Spring has been a season of revival for the youth in Northern New England . That revival has manifested in a variety of ways from service to the community to raising money for missions.

Over the past few months a series of youth rallies have been held in our churches in Waterville (at Prayer Conference with many of our churches in attendance), East Machias, Concord, Bangor, and Ellsworth. There were also regular youth services with a revival emphasis in Belfast, Mattawamkeag, and Augusta. The Lord has met our youth in this time of revival and changed lives for eternity.

Dozens responded to the altar calls and made commitments to the Lord. Between the 5 rallies, at least 47 responded to a salvation altar call and dozens were filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke in other tongues! Dozens more committed their lives to the Lord more completely and to a lifestyle of holiness. In East Machias, one after another, students stood up, threw their hands up to God and cried, "Whatever you want, God!", declaring their willingness to go wherever and do whatever God asked of them.

All too often revival begins and ends in an altar service. This was not the case this time! Reports are coming from every direction of a new zeal for God in our youth groups across the region. The East Machias group has reported a transformation in lives as well as the group as a whole. More churches than ever before on record have participated in the YWEA project to raise money for orphanages in Bogata, Columbia and Nogales Mexico. Over \$7,500 has come in already, eclipsing our 5 year average by 30%!

As an example of living out their faith, the Waterville youth group conducted a help-a-thon to raise money for YWEA and to impact their community, as they do every year. They chose several projects as a team and solicited friends and family to pledge money per hour to the YWEA missions project for each hour they worked. Projects included the local homeless shelter, food bank, city parks clean-ups, the Salvation Army, the Waterville Fire Department and families in the neighborhood of the church. The response was overwhelming as the community was impressed with a group of teens that choose to give of their time and of themselves.

The call to revival comes from the pulpit. The commitment to revival happens in the altar. But to live out revival requires every facet of your life, every minute of your time, and part of your mind will and emotions. Revival is in the mundane as well as the exceptional. Revival is a lifestyle.
